I arrived at the intake desk for Small Claims and informed Amanda that I had a few error forms to be filed. I further informed her that, as the form does not indicate how many copies are necessary, I'd brought one for the court and one for myself. She said that they needed three copies: court, other party, and self.

I drove to the UPS store to obtain another copy and was told they would not be able to complete the copies for another couple hours.

Monday, June 26, 2017

I drove to the UPS store this a.m. for third copy and went to the courthouse. I told Missy that I wished to file error forms and had brought three copies. She said she needed only one copy.

Given my experience with this court's choice to respond to opposing counsel rather than reply to my letter of 3/14/17, I have to seriously wonder what is going on here beyond mere confusion and/or ignorance of process. Governor Walker's office has provided some information on how I am able to follow-up on these concerns.
